Nepal

Westminster Biblical Missions is privileged to support the work of our faithful brothers and sisters in Nepal, with Pastor Dennis Roe serving as our field chairman. This ministry began through God's providence in the spring of 2015, when Pastor Roe met Pastor Krishna "Caleb" Acharya at a Western Classis meeting of the Reformed Church in the U.S. At that gathering, Pastor Caleb—a native of Nepal—learned of Pastor Roe's passion for missions and his involvement with WBM. He invited Pastor Roe to visit Nepal and see the Gospel needs firsthand.

Since that initial meeting, Pastors Roe and Caleb have made numerous trips to Nepal, striving to strengthen and develop faithful leadership for the growing number of churches across the country. Through their extensive network, Bible conferences for men and women are held regularly in central and western Nepal, equipping Christian leaders and their wives for effective ministry.

Ministry Regions in Nepal

Kathmandu Region

Led by Rev. Janak and Rev. Purna, this ministry is rooted in both pastoral care and practical outreach.



In addition to his pastoral duties, Rev. Janak operates a travel and tourism business and oversees the Mercy Stay Home, a guest home that serves immigrants. Pastor Purna manages a Christian school and a sewing center, while also caring for orphans in impoverished neighborhoods such as the one pictured.

Chitwan Region

Rev. Krishna Pandey, his son Sanish, and their family operate the Mercy Home Orphanage and the Mercy Center. Rev. Pandey also pastors



Trinity Reformed Church, which meets at the Mercy Center. Their outreach extends into the mountains and rural villages, where they are actively engaged in evangelism, church planting, building Christian schools, and developing water projects.

Western Nepal

This region is served by Revs. Mohan, Prashant, and Udaya, who focus on evangelism and church planting in remote areas. They oversee sewing centers that equip women with skills to help support their families and provide care for orphans by welcoming them into their homes. The advance of the Gospel in this region has sparked numerous projects, including the construction of churches and Christian meeting places.

A Growing Church

A major milestone of this mission has been the founding of the Reformed Presbyterian Church in Nepal. Although still in its formative stages, foundational Reformed confessions are being translated, printed, taught, and promoted. Meanwhile, the first group of leaders is undergoing training in Reformed doctrine and Presbyterian polity.
