There was also focus on teaching theology and sound doctrine.

Our church in the Himalayan foothills northeast of Chitwan is doing well and the believers are

increasing in number. Meetings like those in Gorkha were held with the leaders there to encourage and strengthen them.

LOCAL MINISTRY: Friday youth fellowship has also resumed in person. In Chitwan, Pastor Krishna and Sanish are teaching through the Crucial Questions booklet series by R.C. Sproul. The series is still being translated by Sanish one booklet at a time and many of the titles are already completed. Our church members are given copies as soon as each booklet is finished. This series addresses such questions as Who is Jesus?, Can I Trust the Bible?, What is Faith? and much more. We thank God for Ligonier ministries providing these materials without cost.

HELP PROVIDED: Due to the unexpected four days of heavy rain and flooding, nearly half of the rice harvest was lost for the orphanage and also for the local village. We thank God that through your gracious giving we have been able to help them with this loss.

Pray for Pastor Krishna and Sanish as they provide training for the Lord to raise up Godly leaders and faithful fellow servants.

YOUTH MINISTRY: A three day youth seminar is planned to be held in the Bardiya area where we now have approximately ten churches which will participate. A Bible quiz is planned in order to challenge the youth to study and know the content of the Bible. Please pray that it will be enjoyed by many and be a blessing to all.
