- ♥ We praise the Lord that for the **first time**, members of the WBM Board were able to meet by Zoom video in January with Revs. Sardar Ahmed Din, Emmanuel Gill and Nasir Lal Din. We hope to do this at least twice yearly, God willing.
- ♥ We are thankful, with you all, that on January 18, Calvin’s Academies 1, 2 and 3 re-opened for 9th and 10th grade students under Standard Operating Procedures established by the government!
- ♥ We praise God for unexpected blessings upon the PLM churches including your brothers and sisters praying more than before and being serious about their faith and worship, according to Rev. Emmanuel Gill.
- ♥ Thank God with us for enough funds received by the Pakistan Lahore Ministry (PLM) to help us fund our gospel labors the first quarter of 2021.

PRAYING FOR BETTER DAYS IN FEBRUARY

- † Please keep praying with us about a COVID vaccine, as the **Pakistan Nation Newspaper** reported January 20th that . . . *top federal government health authorities have confirmed that Pakistan has neither **placed** any final order yet to acquire the COVID-19 vaccine nor has any vaccine manufacturer **accepted** the country’s request for supply of the vaccine.*
- † Please pray as the Pakistani government has asked to open the schools for **1-8th grade students on February 1**. The PLM hopes these younger students will be back soon.
- † Pray that soon enough funds will be donated to the PLM to help us fund our gospel labors for the Spring, Summer and Fall quarters of 2021.
- † Please pray for the PLM churches regarding the economic strains on their families and pastors, and their fears about the future as they long to meet as normal.
- † Please continue to pray that our merciful God would diminish the pandemic to the point that Rev. Emmanuel Gill may come to the USA this Spring so that he may be able to visit our supporters. Please pray that travel funds will be provided for him. (NOTE: \$750 of the approximately \$3,000 needed has been donated so far).
