Pakistan Lahore

The Pakistan Lahore Ministry (PLM) was founded over fifty years ago under the leadership of Rev. Sardar Ahmed Din. In response to the rise of neo-evangelicalism and liberalism, a Reformed church was established known as the Bible-Believing Lahore Church Council (BBLCCL). Since then, the BBLCCL has grown to nearly fifty congregations across Lahore, Faisalabad, and Islamabad, served by approximately forty pastors—many of whom oversee two or three congregations. Rev. Emmanuel Gill currently serves as Director of Ministries, supported by a seven-member Board of Directors based in Lahore. Here in the U.S., Rev. Howard Sloan serves as our Field Chairman for Pakistan.



Pastoral training takes place at the Presbyterian Theological Seminary in Lahore, where currently four to five students are preparing for ministry. Their curriculum includes instruction in Bible, Theology, Church History, and Biblical Languages.



There is a significant need to provide Christian education for underprivileged children, giving them the opportunity to learn the Scriptures and own a Bible in the Urdu language. The BBLCCL operates five schools under the name Calvin's Academy, serving approximately 1,500 students. Thanks to donor support, Calvin's Academy #2 is constructing a new facility. Calvin Academies IV and V also hope to build new facilities, as both currently operate in rented buildings. A plot of land has already been secured for Academy IV and awaits funding.



Many of the families in these communities live in deep poverty. A sewing program has been established to teach young girls skills in tailoring, enabling them to help support their families financially. Additionally, to combat widespread illiteracy, approximately 35 literacy centers have been established where pastors teach reading using the Urdu Bible as the primary text.

Access to healthcare is also a major challenge for the poorest families. The Lord has graciously provided BBLCCL with two medical clinics, located in Asif Town-2 and Muridke. Each clinic is staffed with a doctor and includes a dispensary to meet basic health needs.

Annual Bible conferences minister to thousands of Pakistani believers, focusing on the great doctrines of the faith. Members of the Westminster Biblical Missions (WBM) team often serve as conference speakers. The summer camp held in Murree Hills provides another valuable opportunity for believers to study God's Word and enjoy fellowship together.
