RECENT VIOLENCE

While there is much good to report about Pakistan, sadly there is also much cause for concern and prayer. According to Morning Star News, a group of Muslim terrorists recently opened fire on a church and several homes in a Christian community in Lahore. A child was killed and many others were wounded. This neighborhood is 17 miles from our main campus in Asif Town-2 and 10 miles from Rev. Emmanuel Gill's congregation.

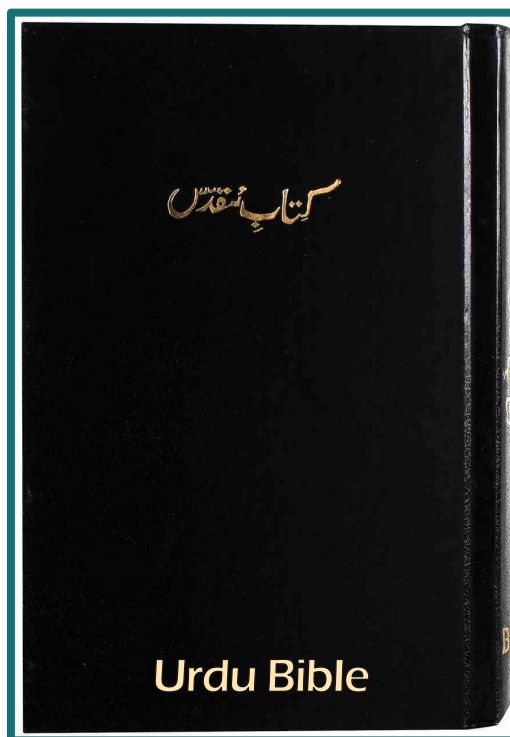


Although there is no BBLCCCL church in the immediate area, a similar incident occurred a similar incident occurred near the area where Rev. Nasir Lal Din resides. We thank God that no one was harmed. Rev. Gill wrote, *"Though directly none of our people were injured, there is grave concern because as Christians we are one body. Furthermore, in the sight of Mus-lims, there is no difference among Christian denominations. Roman Catholic, Anglican, and Presbyterian are all Christians in their sight."*

While praying for Pakistan, we cannot ignore the plight of Afghanistan. Afghani Christians are in great jeopardy there. Many have already given their lives in the name of Christ. The Taliban's evil influence has certainly been felt in Pakistan and is increasing. Please pray for spiritual courage for the Christians in Afghanistan and Pakistan. May our Lord Jesus grant them the strength, wisdom, and boldness to be His witnesses, and may He use this to turn the enemies of the Gospel into children of the King.

FALL BIBLE CONFERENCES

The Fall Bible Conferences are scheduled to start in late October. It is our desire to send speakers from the United States for these



conferences. However both security and COVID concerns may render this impossible. Our Pakistani brothers have been requesting a visit for some of time and if we need to cancel this trip it will be disheartening for our Pakistani brethren as they desire our encouragement and support. Please pray that things will be stable enough so that we will be able to visit soon.

FINAL NOTES FOR PRAYER

The fall board meeting of WBM is scheduled for Saturday, October 16th. Please pray for God's blessing as our board members, field chairmen, and missionaries gather for a

virtual meeting to consider the matters of the various ministries of WBM.

We have a need for Urdu Bibles as follows: 250 Bibles for their 30 Bible literacy centers, 550 Bibles for the four Calvin Academies, and 50 Bibles for the churches. The total cost will be \$2760. Please pray for this need and help as you are able.

Once again, we thank you for your prayers and financial support, which mean so much to us at WBM and to your brothers and sisters in Pakistan. May the Kingdom of Christ continue to grow here, in Pakistan, and around the world to the glory of God!
