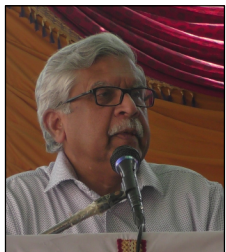

Pakistan - Village



Dr. Samuel David leads the Pakistan Village Ministry (PVM), an organization founded by his father, the

late Rev. Alexander David, a dedicated church planter. Through a variety of ministries in the villages surrounding Sahiwal, the Pakistan Village Ministry strives to reach people with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Its goal is to fortify the faith of Christians by providing robust biblical teaching and preaching. Recognizing the increasing prevalence of false doctrines and unbiblical practices in Pakistan, particularly among those in the villages who are susceptible to misinformation, the ministry aims to ensure accurate biblical instruction.

Pastor Majeed Masih has proven to be a significant blessing to Village #12. In addition to his teaching and preaching responsibilities, he has reorganized the Sunday School and young adult ministry. Furthermore, he

oversees the Sewing Center within this village. His primary focus is to cultivate and strengthen the Christian faith of the younger generation in Village #12.

Pastor Stephen Ashiq leads the congregation in Rattian Village #130. This congregation joined the ministry two years ago while in the process of constructing their church in this predominantly Muslim area. The Pakistan Village Ministry assisted in the building of their church, which was completed last year. Residing within a Muslim-majority community, this beautiful church building brings great joy and pride to the congregation as they gather regularly for worship.

Village #174, where the village ministry began, is also home to the **David Memorial School**. This school has served as a source of blessing for

families within the village and continues to stand as a vital Christian witness to the surrounding villages.

Sewing Centers for Women:

Our ministry has also established sewing centers in these villages. Beyond acquiring sewing skills, the women also learn to read and study the Word of God. Upon completion of the course, they receive a sewing machine and a graduation certificate. Equipped with their new skills and machines, they are enabled to help support their families. Our Sewing Centers have proven to be a great benefit for both the families and the wider village communities.

Reformed Books in Urdu: A

collection of Reformed books is available in Urdu, featuring works written and translated by Rev. Alexander David, and materials from Dr. R.C. Sproul and other Reformed authors. These books are distributed to pastors, lay leaders, teachers, and teaching institutions. Current efforts are focused on revising and reprinting Rev. David's writings for continued distribution.
