Greetings in the precious name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

We praise God for His continued care and protection as PVM ministers among villages in Pakistan to provide education, training, and gospel preaching, building them in their faith. As people continue to face persecution and threats of violence by fundamentalists, we need continued prayers for Christians in Pakistan.

In recent years, the current government seems to act favorably towards minorities by allowing access to special events during Christmas and Easter, but with recent court ruling about the marriage of underage girls to Muslims, there is anger and fear among Christian parents that their young daughters are vulnerable to kidnapping and forced marriages by Muslims. We ask for prayers and wisdom for Christian leadership in Pakistan as they protest this ruling.

Gospel Ministry: Village # 130, Faisal Abad.

Saint Paul's Presbyterian Church is located at Village #130 near Faisalabad. Pastor Stephan Masih ministers to this congregation. The young man pictured with him helps in Sunday school and Bible studies. He plans to attend Bible school along with his Lab Tech training.

We thank the Lord that both congregations are in Muslim villages, yet there has never been an incident of discrimination or violence towards Christians in these villages, and we pray that the Lord will protect his people and their testimony among Muslims. Recently, villages once known as Christian are no longer majority-Christian, as Muslims have purchased much of the land and built homes and mosques there.



Village #112 Sahiwal

Village #112 congregation has encountered several significant challenges over the past few years. Now we are reporting another change: We have a new pastor at this congregation. Pastor Majeed worked diligently for two years, but his recent involvement with the congregation has decreased. Due to his health issues, he was not able to travel much. The congregation invited Pastor Azmat Masih to preach several times and then chose him as their new pastor. Pastor Masih and his wife's name, Sheeza, are both are young and well-liked by people of all ages in this congregation. He has started morning and evening worship services daily. The congregation is growing quickly.

We supplied Pastor Masih with quality Reformed books in Urdu. There are plans to arrange virtual

Pastor Majeed had started building Sunday school, but then, due to his health reasons, he was not able to keep up with work. Pastor Azmat and his wife have already started working with children and youth.

Village #174 Sahiwal

Not long ago there was a theft in Village 174. Our school and the village church were targeted. The incident occurred early in the morning during dense fog, which prevented the security cameras from capturing any footage. The thieves cut and stole the water filtration system and pipes from the village church, and the water motor and a ceiling fan from our school. They also broke into the school office and the locker where the security guard's supplies were kept.

David Memorial School at Village #174.

We thank and praise God for the privilege to provide education to our young children in this village. The school is a blessing for the village families



and the congregation in this village.

Besides their regular education, they learn the Word of God in their Bible class during the week and at Sunday school on the Lord's Day. The pastor's daughter is one of our Bible teachers, who continues to involve them in practical Sunday school activities during church services.

Our school achieves better overall results than others in the area. Two of our high school students received a government college scholarship. After finishing college, they enrolled in Nursing school to earn their BSN. We praise God for these girls who are sisters. We help the family by supporting their tuition costs. At present, our school has all the staff it needs, though we may require more teachers soon.

Feroza Sewing Center at Village #174

We are grateful that our inaugural sewing class graduated last month and held their ceremony just before Easter. All ten students graduated and received a sewing machine along with the Certificate of Completion.

Currently we are in the process of registering students for the next class.

We need prayers and funds for the following needs. We cordially encourage your

2. We need more desks for several classes.

3. Day school for Boys at Village #174. (Future project)
